

GUIDELINES FOR TRASH & RECYCLING TOWN OF BROOKEVILLE

IMPORTANT

Put all recyclables and trash out at the curb before 7:00 a.m.

RECYCLABLE BLUE BIN ITEMS

GLASS JARS & BOTTLES

We accept:

- All food and beverage jars and bottles

Sorry,

- NO other glass or ceramic products

CANS & FOIL PRODUCTS

We accept:

- All metal food, beverage, and pet food cans.
- Aluminum foil products. Examples: foil wrap, pie plates and other food trays. (Please clean and wipe off foil.)

PLASTIC BOTTLES

Confused about those resin codes?

Resin codes are the numbers you find on the bottom of plastic containers and bottles. To make recycling easier for residents, we no longer use these codes (numbers 1 through 7) to determine whether a plastic item is acceptable or not. Now, we use the following criterion: if the plastic container has a narrow neck opening (like a bottle), then you may recycle it on our program. If the plastic container is not a bottle, please dispose of it as trash.

We accept:

- Clear and colored plastic bottles with necks.

Sorry,

- NO other plastics Examples: yogurt containers, margarine tubs, pint-sized baskets for fruit, beverage cups, salad bar containers, flower pots
- NO bottles from hazardous products. Examples: automotive and garden products.
- NO lids or caps, please.

MIXED PAPER

- Acceptable materials can be combined together and placed in paper bags
- Flatten all empty boxes and put into bundles.
- Shredded paper is fine. Just secure it in a paper bag or clear plastic bag

We accept:

- ✓ Newspapers and inserts ✓ Magazines ✓ Corrugated cardboard ✓ Catalogs
- ✓ Cereal & other boxes ✓ Paperback books ✓ Telephone books ✓ Unwanted mail
- ✓ Computer & office paper ✓ All other clean & dry paper

Sorry,

- NO packing material such as styrofoam or plastic.
- NO waxed paper, carbon paper, hard backed books, beverage containers such as milk or juice cartons.
- NO paper or cardboard contaminated with paint, chemicals, food or kitty litter.
- NO foil gift-wrap, paper towels, napkins or tissues.
